* MSA: the treasurer's report was approved as presented.

Fire Chief Report

- The wildland refresher was held this month, and all went well.
- The CAT generator has been sold and shipped to its new owner in New Mexico.
- Chief Jameson has found 10 newer SCBA equipment for the price of \$500.00 per unit. Chief Jameson would like to purchase them for the total amount of \$5,000.00.
 - a. * MSA: The Board agreed to purchase the replacement SCBA equipment for \$8,000.00 to be paid out of the Board of Directors Stipend Fund from ColoTrust.
- Chief Jameson found 10 SCBA units from Frasier Fire that are being donated to the LVFPD for free.
 There is another district that is in need of SCBA equipment that Chief Jameson is recommending donating our old equipment to for their benefit.
- Chief Jameson would like to promote Justin Jameson and David Steffan to the position of Captain.
 - a. * MSA: The Board of Directors agreed with the promotion of Justin Jameson and David Steffan into the position of Captain and Eric Guadagnoli into the position of Lieutenant.
- There was extensive discussion regarding the new ordinance that is being implemented by the County Commissioners. The County Commissioners is looking at taking over the issuance of burn permits rather than it being each Fire district issuing them. Chief Jameson will be attending the upcoming meeting to discuss the issue with the County Commissioners. Chief Jameson is requesting a letter from the Board of Directors addressed to the County Commissioners regarding our opinion and feelings regarding the ordinance.
 - a. *MSA: The Board of Directors agreed to write a letter to the County Commissioners regarding the ordinance addressed to the County Commissioners.
- Chief Jameson would like to purchase a large American Flag to hang from the ladder truck during special events.
- There was discussion regarding training on the VHF radio system.
