Guests, Correspondence, and Presenters

• The representatives from the La Veta Village addressed the Board of Directors regarding the use of the community room for storing and utilizing our building for the distribution of food boxes to people in our community that are in need. There was discussion about the electricity needs and the ability of securing the Community Room from the rest of the building. The food distribution is done 2 Saturdays each month. The Board of Directors agreed to allow them to use the building starting in January 2021. They will be bringing 3 upright freezers, 1 chest freezer, and 1 office freezer.

Fire Chief Report

- 1. We had a good response on the mutual aid call for the forest service fire. The forest service was appreciative of our help.
- 2. Training was over SCBA training.
- 3. Chief Jameson recommended that we sell the old Rescue 4 (San Isabel Electric Ford).
- 4. Chief Jameson made a recommendation for purchasing a slide-in unit for the UTV so it can be utilized more effectively and be a better utilization of our equipment.
- 5. Chief Jameson ordered a new ladder for the new 6501 fire truck.

EMT Director's Report:

- 1. Waiting on word about the RETAC grant. (\$6,500.00)
- 2. 18 EMS calls for the month of October. There were 12 patients transported to the hospital and 6 refusals or cancelations.

- Training We had training on operations and opioid overdose. We had a live scenario training at the new build site for the school that included both fire and EMS. We had a good turnout for the training and received good feedback from all involved.
- 4. Maintenance there were no maintenance issues.
- 5. Tires for R-1 are ordered.
- 6. Director Mower addressed the Board regarding the commitment for the district payment of the tuition for volunteers of the district. He would like to extend the time from 2 years to 3 years for the paramedic student.
