Guests, Correspondence, and Presenters

We received 2 donations for the LVFPD EMS department totaling \$1,100.00 to be applied for the purchase of the new LifePak 15. We received a letter from the CW&S regarding the failed water testing in 2020. All had been resolved.

Treasurer's Report

* MSA: the treasurer's report was approved as presented.

Fire Chief Report

- The annual hose testing that is performed by KAT had to be postponed due to mechanical issues with their equipment.
- Training was combined with EMS covering communication and radio use.
- We are still waiting for the programing of the new radio to be completed. We are waiting for Paul Gomez to receive a key to program the new radios.
- Station 2 is now the property of the LVFPD thanks to the generous donation of the property to us by Triangle Investment, LLC.
- We had a total of 5 fire calls.

EMT Director's Report:

- We had 16 total calls, 7 were transported to the ER, 9 were refusals or cancelations.
- Maintenance: no maintenance this month.
- Training: we covered opioid overdoses.
- We will have to change the way some of our reporting will have to change due to CMS reporting requirements.

Administrator's Report:

• We have received the \$5,346.00 from the VFA grant.

Old Business

• The La Veta School building construction is moving forward. The water has been hooked up.

- Generator Update: Just waiting for an answer from CAT.
- The 4-Rivers credit application discussion. 4-Rivers was contacted and because we are a government agency, we do not need to have a personal guarantor. It was agreed to have an account with them but not a charge account.

New Business

- The 2022 budget was presented to the Board of Directors. 25% was added to the fuel line item and the propane due to the increase in fuel cost. The Board of Directors agreed with the 2022 budget.
- * MSA: Approved the draft of the 2022 budget.
- A review of the education contract was requested due to the upcoming EMS Basic class that will be starting in November 2021. LVFPD will be hosting the EMS Basic class from Pikes Peak Community College. There was no discussion regarding the education contract.
- We will be able to get the DFPC driving training unit this winter for about 2 months.
- MSA: The Board of Directors approved Kristin Smith to join the LVFPD membership.
